


Procedure for test/ interview required to qualify as Chartered Electrical Safety Engineer (CESE).

(Guideline No. CEI/1/2/2018 dated 21st June, 2018 of Chief Engineer Central Electrical Authority)

1. Candidates satisfying the following requirements as on the date of application may apply for appearing in the qualifying test / interview for the authorisation of the Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers :-
 - a) Candidates must be a resident of West Bengal.
 - b) He/ she must not be above 65 years of age.
 - c) He/she must have 5 years post qualification experience for Degree holders and 10 years post qualification experience for Diploma holders in operation and maintenance of electrical installations and also should have the knowledge of the works related to observance of electrical safety regulations.
 - d) He/she must not hold any post in Govt./Semi Govt./PSUs or associated with any organizations which directly or indirectly influence the working of Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers.
 - e) He/she must possess S.C.C or N.C.S licenses granted under West Bengal Electrical Licensing Rule, 2017.
 - f) He/she must possess the NABL accredited testing equipments as prescribed by the office of the Chief Electrical Inspector, West Bengal (Refer; Annexure-I).
 - g) Registration fee of Rs 10000/- should be deposited through GRIPS under the Head: 0043-00-103-001-16.
 - h) Relevant documents in support of a) Residence, b) Age, c) Qualification, d) Experience, e) S.C.C/N.C.S License, f) Test Certificates of all the instruments possessed are to be submitted along with the prescribed Application Form.
2. Eligible candidates should apply in the prescribed Format 'X' with proof of deposit of prescribed fees to the Chief Electrical Inspector, West Bengal, Directorate of Electricity, 11A, N.S. Road, Kolkata Collectorate Building, Kolkata-700001 on Notification for the qualifying test by the Chief Electrical Inspector.
3. The Chief Electrical Inspector on receipt of the applications will verify the information submitted by the eligible candidates and on satisfaction of the minimum eligible norms admit candidates for the qualifying test/interview.
4. The test / interview shall be held by the Chief Electrical Inspector on subjects and topics related to the works assigned to the Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers in terms of the Act and Regulations in force. On satisfaction of the candidates knowledge, both practical and theoretical, the Chief Electrical Inspector shall issue authorisation in Form 'Y'.
5. Steps should be taken for early disposal for all applications and delay if any in disposal of applications beyond 90 days should be recorded and informed to applicants.
