NOTIFICATION

In continuation of the earlier notification of this Department bearing no. 445/PO/O/C-IV/1E-06/12 dated 21.03.2025; it is to further notify that:

- 1. For self-certification up to the Notified Voltage, i.e. 11 kV, duly filled up Form-III of Schedule -II of Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety & Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023, signed by the owner of the installation and certified by the Chartered Electrical Safety Engineer/Graduate Electrical Engineer with National Electrical Supervisory Competence Certificate/Graduate Electrical Engineer with Energy Audit Certificate issued by BEE, Government of India, to be submitted to the Electrical Inspector. The self-certified electrical installation shall be considered fit for the commencement of supply or recommencement after shutdown for six months only after the report of self-certification is duly received by the office of Electrical Inspector and if not acknowledged by the Electrical Inspector within three working days, it shall be deemed to be received.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained above, as per Regulation 45 (1) (b), every electrical installation covered under section 54 of the Electricity Act, 2003, i.e. (a) in any street having 250 watt & 100 volts or, (b) in any place (i) in which one hundred or more persons are ordinarily likely to be assembled or, (ii) which is a factory within the meaning of the Factories Act, 1948 shall be inspected and tested by the Electrical Inspector and as per Regulation No. 32 (4), every installations covered under section 54 of the Electricity Act, 2003, shall be periodically inspected and tested by the Electrical Inspector.
